Palm Sunday

Greetings,

I hope you are well and I pray that you are happy. Today we begin Holy Week and it is my prayer that we all may come to know the seriousness of this week. It can be a time of real personal conversion and renewal.

We gather as a crowd of people and we are given a Palm branch. We wave that branch with all of our brothers and sisters throughout the world. We sing "Hosanna in the Highest." We are no different than the crowd that raised their branches that first Palm Sunday. We are the crowd today and we recognize that Jesus is the King of Kings and Lord of Lords.

But as any crowd, we change real fast. We are so fickle and confused. We put our Palm branches down and lift up our fists. We now yell out, "Crucify Him crucify Him." Jesus is a problem for us. He is upsetting our nice routines, our content way of life. Jesus looks into the very depth of our being and our hearts our pierced. It is not comfortable and we just don't like it. "Crucify Him!" We like our comfortable lifestyle. We want to be in relationship with God according to our way.

Jesus is now on the cross and next to him our two thieves. Oh wait! We are all thieves in one way or another. Jesus is surrounded by many thieves. We are a crowd of thieves... sinners! We push and shove and scream ugly cruel words to one another. We see him on that cross and some of us are truly moved and we recognize what Jesus has done. But many of us don't get it. "You saved others, get us down from this cross." "What kind of a God are you?"

What is important is that we side with the thief who asked Jesus to remember him in Paradise. He recognized his sinfulness and needed a truly new way of living. We can hang out with all of the thieves who just do not recognize God's love or we can hang with the thief that recognized Jesus as Savior. "This day you will be with me in Paradise."



We can hang with a community who believes that Jesus is the way and the truth and the Life. "This day you will be with me in Paradise." Those are the words we should all want to hear. Have a great Holy Week!

Divine Mercy

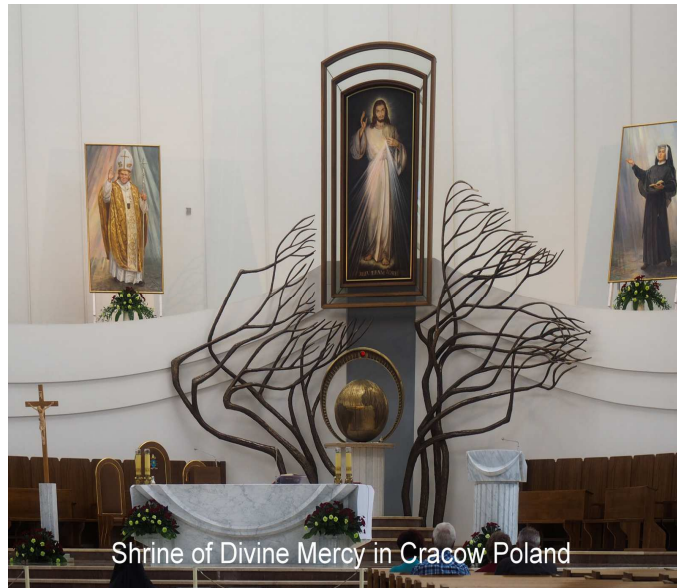

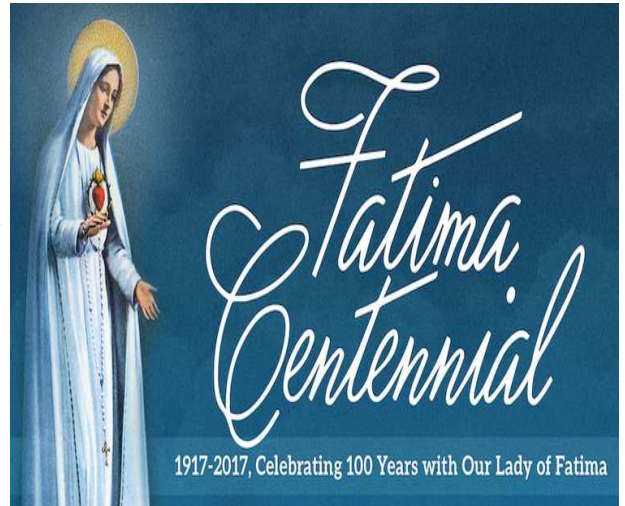
