I hope you are well and I pray that you are happy! I hope you are well... and yet lately I have been witnessing several parishioners who are suffering from illness. I have been called by family members to spend time with a dying mother/father or grandparent. The question arises: "Why all of this suffering?" It is not easy, since we believe in a God of Love, peace and joy. And yet...it remains suffering and pain.

In our second reading for this week, Peter says: "For Christ also suffered for sins once, the righteous for the sake of the unrighteous, that he might lead you to God. Put to death in the flesh, he was brought to life in the Spirit." Our Lord suffered as well. He was whipped and crowned with thorns and nailed to a cross. I would imagine that would be a bit painful. His suffering however was for good, that he might lead us to God. He suffered so that we can be set free. He suffered for good and not for evil. Jesus did not want to suffer..."If possible let this cup pass me by." (Matthew 26:39). Jesus sweat blood for all of us and as a human like us in all things but sin, Jesus also said "not my will but your will be done." As a human we all look for other ways and even though we do not understand, we

trust in God and follow God's will.

So our suffering and pain, even though difficult to bear, we live for good. We embrace Jesus who suffered and we give our lives in love to our family, friends and even our enemies. Believe me when I say I hate suffering and pain just as much as the next person but I also have faith knowing that God is with me. I give that pain and that suffering to God and I offer it to do good for others.

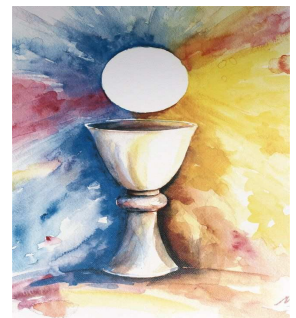

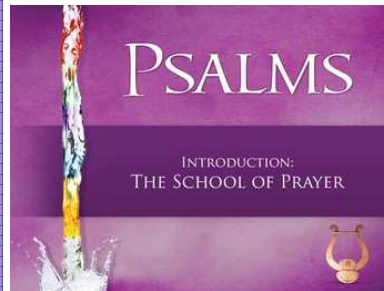

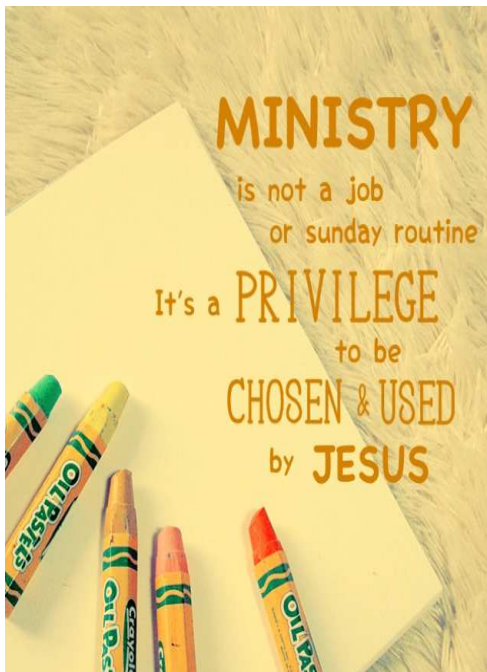
