Shower Monitor

Shower Monitor Volunteer Responsibilities November through March

- Arrive at 6:00 PM.
- Turn on water in Boiler Room (valve is located beside water heater.)
- Collect Shower Sign-in Sheet.
- Be sure hamper is lined with a large plastic bag.
- Get shower supplies from metal cabinet in entry area; arrange for distribution.
 - Towels, toothpaste, toothbrushes, hair dryer (check-out item), nail clippers, disposable razor, shower stool, etc.
- Call first person on list for shower, give towel, wash cloth and any other requested items from above list.
- Backpacks and purses may not be taken into the shower. They will be stored on the cabinet while owner is in the shower. Small, clear toiletry bags may be taken in to the shower once inspected by the Shower Monitor.
- Remind guest of 15 minute time limit and that you will knock on the door to remind them with 5 minutes remaining.
- Inform next guest it will be their turn in 5 minutes.
- If guest is not out in 15 minutes, knock and tell them it's time for the next person to use the shower. If guest does not comply, you may turn off the water in the Boiler Room.
- Direct guests to place used towel/washcloth in lined hamper.
- Check shower after each use and spray shower floor and seat with bleach solution.
- Hairdryer is to be used outside of the bathroom in the entry.
- If hair dryer is used, check it back in when finished.
- At conclusion of the evening, check bathroom for cleanliness (full cleaning will occur in the morning). Spray with Tilex cleaner and do not rinse.
- Tie laundry bag closed for morning pick-up.
- Turn off water in Boiler Room.
- Return supplies to cart storage. Identify needed supplies and add to list on kitchen counter.
- Finished by 8:30 PM.

Shower Monitor

- Make sure notes regarding dinner are entered in the Meal Log of attendance notebook. Include information about sufficient portions and guest feedback.

Shower Monitor Volunteer Responsibilities 3rd Sunday Showers April through October

- Arrive at 2:45 PM and set up one table with chairs. May offer water and card games during wait.
- Access Custodial office to set out and then retrieve two StA-SWS signs. Place one at McKenzie St and one at Stairwell.
- Two volunteers monitor Shower and Shelter environment.
- Follow procedures for Shower Monitor Volunteer Responsibilities: November through March for 15 minute showers between 3 and 5 PM.
- If there are no additional guests signed up for showers by 4:30, it is permissible to close early.
