St. Anthony offers more than just the required core curriculum. A variety of field trips, service projects, and hands-on learning opportunities are integrated into each grade.

Giving back to the community and those less fortunate is strongly emphasized at St. Anthony. Classroom service projects and school-wide service projects are on-going at all grade levels. Our middle school students are required to give 20 hours of community service every year. This requirement is easily met and often surpassed as our students have embraced the idea that giving can be more rewarding than receiving.

Students are offered an opportunity to share projects they've completed and talents they possess. All grades participate in the annual Christmas Program and Specials Fair. A Science Fair, State and County Fair and Middle School play showcase our older students' talents.
