Greetings ,

I hope you are well and I pray that you are happy! Today we celebrate the Baptism of our Lord. When Jesus came out of the water the heavens opened and a voice was heard: "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased." We see in this baptism a relationship between Father and Son and Holy Spirit. Jesus did not have to be baptized but he wanted us to understand that we, are in relationship with the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. I might add that we are also in relationship with the Church. When you and I were baptized we were sealed with a permanent mark at the center of our being. Therefore it only happens once. When we do not recognize a person's baptism then it becomes merely symbolic.

In the baptism of Jesus we also realize that Jesus embraced all of our sins. He suffered and died on the cross for our sins. Our Lord identified with you and me. That is so powerful and so in Baptism we discover love, God's love and we are forgiven.

So this day I ask all of us to pray for our church that we may all deepen our relationship with God. I also ask us to embrace God's love and live that love in everything we do. We should be reminded of our baptism every time we bless ourselves and in every action of our life.

The Prophet Nathan told powerful King David about a poor shepherd having only one sheep and how that sheep had been stolen by a rich man with many sheep (2 Samuel 12:2). David flew into a rage, demanding to know who the thief was so he could punish him. Nathan calmly told David, "You are the one." God had revealed to Nathan how David had stolen the affections of Bathsheba and then arranged for her husband, Uriah, to die in battle. Like David, we may not recognize our transgressions. David had Nathan to clue him in. Do we have someone in our life to clue us in when we do wrong? Do we fly into a rage when confronted and remain steadfast, or like David, do we see our transgression and change course?

Women's Retreat: February 22 – 24, 2019

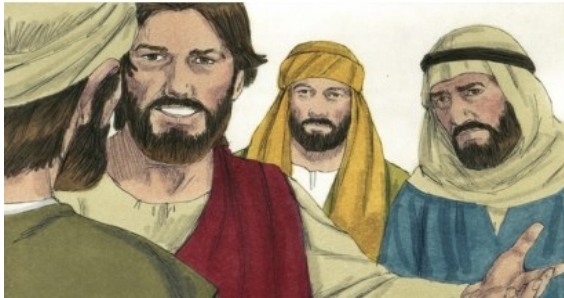
The women of Our Lady of the Lake Parish, invite you to join us for a weekend retreat at Our Lady of Peace Retreat House, in Beaverton.

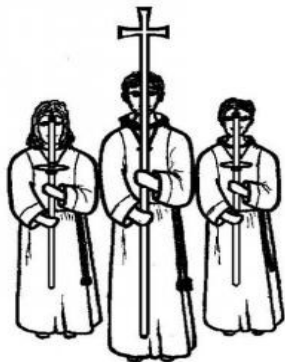
